



What is a Digital Exchange System?

A network of national (case management) systems and/or Reference Implementation(s) connected to the same e-CODEX network and supporting document exchanges within the same cross-border judicial procedures.










What is a Reference Implementation portal?

A user interface, distributed as a portal, that is able to support the basic workflows of a cross-border judicial procedure, in the all EU languages.




